Eremias pleskei BEDRIAGA, 1907 Pleske's Racerunner

Identification: More slender bodied than *E. strauchi*, with a total length up to 15 cm. Occipital absent; subocular in contact with edge of the mouth. 48-63 rows of scales around mid-trunk; femoral pores between 7-18, their rows more apart medially (the medial space usually 1/3 the length of a single row). The dorsum is brown with longitudinal lighter colored lines. The venter is white or cream colored.

Habitat & Biology: Inhabits arid, sandy, partly rocky areas with semidesert conditions; hides under stones. Feeds on insects and plant material. A female lays 2-4 eggs.

Distribution: Known from Turkey, NW Iran and Armenia; with a vertical distribution between 500-1700 m. Lives in the vicinity of Iğdır in E Anatolia
